OTHER EVENTS

During the Israel Festival Jerusalem, apart from performances by established Israeli dance companies, such as the Kibbutz Dance Company, Tnuatron, the Magma Dance Group and the Ensemble, Jerusalem, special dance events took place —— due to the latest developments in movement-theatre, it isn't always easy to decide, which show belongs to "dance" and which is "theatre"... In these events well-known choreographers, among them Ruth Eshel, Eli Dor-Cohen, Sally-Anne Friedland, Adina Bar-On, Marit Ben-Israel and Ruth Ziv-Eyal showed their new works.

During 1986 the renovated hall at Yad-Lebanim in Tel Aviv became a dance venue, where under the auspices of the Israel Dance Library several performances and lecture-evenings took place. Ran Shinar showed his Indian dance lecture-dem.; Yaron Margolin's company premiered new works; the Navadim Group performed there.

During the year Miri and Gili Haruvi returned from a long stay in London and performed some of their own works.

Several independent choreographers continued their creative work, such as Rina Shaham, who appeared with her group in "Between Light and Darkness", an evening of dance; Ruth Ziv-Eyal premiered her dance-theatre work "Window" (during the Israel Festival) and Nava Zukerman took her "Tmu-Na" dance theatre group to the Edinburg Festival with her "5 Screams".

The renewed cultural relations with Poland (and Hungary, the "Györ Ballet") not only brought dance companies from abroad to Isreal, but also Bat Dor dance company toured several cities in Poland. The Polish "Mazowsze" ensamble came and showed staged folk dance at its best.

Batsheva undertook a controversial tour to South Africa, which generated a lot of comment, pro and contra, in the mass media in Israel.

Visiting companies from abroad included the Basel Ballet from Switzerland, in Heinz Spörli's sparkling version of "Giselle" and a luckluster "Swan Lake", performed by the Sadler's Wells company from London. Meredith Monk participated in the Israel Festival, as did Bill T. Jones and Arnie Zane and their company, in two programs each.

A group of soloists of the Paris Opera Ballet gave an evening of mixed works and duets.

Luis P. Davila ("Lusillo") arrived with his Teatro de Danza Española.

In September the conference on Jewish dance traditions took place in New York, in which several Israeli dance perosonalities participated, including "Inbal Dance Theatre."

The Israel Dance Library, in conjunction with Sifriat Poalim Publishing House, published a book about Baruch Agadati, the pioneer of modern dance in Israel, edited by Giora Manor.

In Haifa the 6th International Folklore Festival took place in July, in which 21 Israeli groups took part as well as ensembles from Great Britain, the U.S.A., Luxemburg, Mexico, Poland, Portugal, Yugoslavia, Spain, West Germany and Bolivia.
