



# The Third International Suzanne Dellal Competition

Between October 16-23, 1996, the Third International Dance Competition was held at the Suzanne Dellal Centre in Tel-Aviv. The event takes place every other year, hence the next one will commence in 1998.

Companies from the following countries took part: France, Argentina, Spain, Brazil, Belgium, Slovenia, the U.S.A. and of course from Israel. The organizers of the competition learned from past mistakes and this time the event ran very smoothly. The jury consisted of the following adjudicators: Gideon Paz (Israel), chairperson; Jean-Paul Montanari (France); Samuel F. Wuersten (Holland); Shelley Sheer (Israel); Eva-Elizabeth Fischer (Germany); Nir Ben-Gal (Israel) and Nils Chrisre (Holland).

Thirteen works were presented. The jury chose six for the final round. Three equal prizes of 10,000 dollars each were awarded to John Jasperse (U.S.A.) to Roxana Grinstein (Argentina) and to Iztok Kovac (Slovenia). The audience, which faithfully filled the hall and applauded enthusiastically, voted to present the Spectator's Prize to the Brazilian choreographer Henrique Rodovalho.
